WA900 - 2.5dozen at 60, 50 and 40 metres – (Master 50+/Senior, U21 & U18)  
**Archery GB Rounds**  
900-70 - 2.5dozen at 70, 60 and 50 metres – (U21)  
900-50 - 2.5dozen at 50, 40 and 30 metres - (U16), (U15)  
900-40 - 2.5dozen at 40, 30 and 20 metres - (U14)  
900-30 - 2.5dozen at 30, 20 and 10 metres - (U12)

Chronotir timing will be used. Arrows will be shot in ends of 6 arrows. Ends will be shot in details, with a maximum of four archers per target. Where possible all targets will be damage foam bosses. The organiser reserves the right to substitute for straw bosses on the shorter distances. All competitors will be shooting on 122 cm faces.

Two scoreboards will be used on the day to record scores as per Annex A of the rules of shooting.

**Awards:** Subject to the number of entries, awards will be presented based on the age categories above, gender and bowstyle:  
1 to 2 archers – Gold medal awarded only  
3 to 4 archers – Gold and Silver medals awarded  
5 or more archers – Gold, Silver and Bronze medals awarded.  
WA and AGB target awards can be claimed at this event in line with the table below.

**Fees:** £15 per archer.

- Timings:** Tent pitching will be available from 8.00am  
Registration will open from 9.00am  
Equipment checks will be at 9.30am with assembly at 10.00am  
3 ends of practice will commence at 10.15am.  
Awards will take place immediately after shooting concludes.  
A 45-minute lunch break will be taken between the first two distance with a short break given between the second and third distances.
- Rules:** Ends will be shot in 4 minutes. All arrow holes will be marked. Bouncer rule and equipment rules apply. Only clothing in compliance with Rule 307 will be permitted. Archer's names, manufacturers logos, club logos and sponsors logos are allowed. The only other wording or logos permissible must represent archery organisations.  
The tournament organisers have the right to exclude any persons from the field for unreasonable behaviour. The Chairman of Judges is responsible for the safe conduct of the shoot at all times and the judge's decision is final and must be obeyed.  
Proof of membership to Archery GB, or affiliated organisations will be required.
- Parking and Toilets:** Car parking and toilets nearby
- Accessibility:** Gate access can be organised for those with disabilities if information is given on entry form
- Refreshments:** Tea/coffee/soft drinks/cakes/savouries will be available throughout the day.  
Bacon butties will be on offer pre-assembly. Burgers, including vegetarian options, will be available during the lunch break.  
  
Please note that payments for refreshments will be CASH ONLY
- Photography:** In accordance with the Archery GB Safeguarding Children and Young People policy, any person, whether archers or visitors, intending to take photographs, either still or video, are requested to register their intention with the Tournament Organiser. Entrants bringing visitors to the tournament are asked to make them aware of this requirement. Parents & Guardians: Please be aware that unless indicated on the entry form, you are permitting photographs to be taken of you and the archer(s) named on the entry form by the Bowmen of Burleigh official photographer, which they may use on their website and social media platforms.
- Smoking:** Smoking including e-cigarettes will only be permitted behind the tent line, please dispose of all materials and respect any wishes of other competitors. Smoking is not permitted in the clubhouse or any other buildings on site i.e. the toilets
- Drug Testing:** Archers competing at Record Status tournaments will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply, refusal will be treated as a positive result.  
  
Entries from archers under 18 must be acknowledged by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
